

Dear Regional Director,

You'll find lower in this letter the link to the Registration Form for MISSIA International Instructors Seminars for candidates from your Region and the translation in Spanish.

You can recommend your members to participate in the seminar on certification as a Master International Instructor and an international instructor.

In developed IPSC Regions, there already exists an approved national system of IPSC training. Master Instructor in such Regions will have to make sure that the minimum international training standard is already present in the national program which is usually much larger than we'll offer.

Topics of MISSIA International Instructors Seminar

1. MISSIA structure. Classroom.
2. The sequence of training topics handgun, shotgun, rifle. Classroom, range.
3. Safe groups teaching methods. Three groups circle. Range.
4. Removal of the main shooting mistakes. Range.
5. Testing system for athletes and for Instructors. Classroom, range.
6. Certification.

The Seminar is open for a discussion and shares knowledge. The Proposals are accepted.

Every participant needs 200 rounds handgun ammo and 100 rounds shotgun (PCC).

Limits for the participants from each IPSC Region.

New Region - 3 participants,

Medium Region (400-2000 members) - 5 participants

Big Region (2000 members or more) - 10 participants or more.

May I remind you the places, dates of MISSIA Seminars and the minimum criteria.

MISSIA Requirements.

The International IPSC Instructor for every IPSC Region must meet the following minimum criteria:

- Must be able to demonstrate reasonably high shooting skills;
- Must be able to teach and certify new members, passing on his knowledge of safe handling and use of firearms, according to the approved training syllabus;
- Must either be an IROA or NROI member or become one within six months of the date of passing the MISSIA International Instructors Seminar;
- Must be willing to teach people IPSC shooting skills;
- Should be available to conduct IPSC classes during weekends if it is required;
- Must teach a minimum 5 new IPSC members each year per Region;
- Must pass the First Aid Seminar (from approved course provider) or take part in one within six months of the date of passing the MISSIA International Instructors Seminar;
- Must speak English.
